This help document will walk you through installing Microsoft Remote Desktop and using it to access VMIS from a personal PC on Windows 8.1 and 10.

DESCRIPTION

Using VMIS from a personal computer via Microsoft Remote Desktop

NOTE: Off-campus access to VMIS requires the TAMU VPN. See <u>http://u.tamu.edu/KB0010938</u> for VPN installation instructions on personal machines. Please use ZENworks to install Cisco AnyConnect and VMIS on CVM Owned Devices.

VPN is only needed when **NOT** on the TAMU network.

1. Install the app "Microsoft Remote Desktop" from the Microsoft Store (app store). Note: You do not need to be signed in with a Microsoft account to download this app. This app is only available for Windows 8.1 and Windows 10 devices.
